Living Room 4.17m x 3.6m (13'8" x 11'10") Double glazed window to front, radiator, laminate flooring.

Kitchen 1.83m x 3.5m L shape (6' x 11'6" L shape) Double glazed window and door to rear, range of wall and base units with work surface over, stainless steel sink unit, oven, four ring gas hob, plumbing for washing machine, space for fridge freezer, tiled floor, part tiled walls.

Bathroom Double glazed window to rear, three piece suite comprising of panelled bath with mixer tap and shower attachment, wash hand basin with mixer tap and vanity storage under, low level w.c., tiled floor, tiled walls.




