Entrance Hall: Stairs to first floor and carpet as fitted.

Landing: Access to (not ownership) loft and carpet as fitted.

Reception Room: 4.27m x 3.48m (14' x 11'5") Double glazed window to front and carpet as fitted.

Kitchen/Diner: 4.7m x 2.16m (15'5" x 7'1") Recently refurbished and fitted with a range of modern wall and base units with complimentary work surfaces. Integrated oven, hob and filter hood. Space for appliances, part tiled walls and tiled flooring.

Bedroom 1: 4.55m x 2.77m (14'11" x 9'1") Double glazed window to front, built in wardrobe/storage and carpet as fitted.

Bedroom 2: 3.76m x 3.33m (12'4" x 10'11") Double glazed window to rear and carpet as fitted.

Bathroom: Fitted with a three piece suite comprising a low level wc, pedestal wash hand basin and a tiled sided bath with shower over. Chrome heated towel rail, tiled flooring and tiled walls.
