Lounge/Dining Room 6.78m (22'3") x 3.89m (12'9") (narrowing to 2.82m (9'3")) Double glazed window to front, carpet, radiator, shutter style blinds, under stairs cupboard.

Kitchen 2.36m x 2.62m (7'9" x 8'7") Fitted with range of wall and base units with complementary work tops, integrated oven and hob, extractor hood, tiled flooring, ceramic sink, double glazed window to rear, wood door to side, part tiled walls, heated towel rail.
