Through Lounge 6.43m into bay 3.38m (21'1" into bay x 11'1") Double glazed bay window to front, double glazed window to rear, coved ceiling, radiators, feature fireplace, wood flooring.

Kitchen 6.68m x 3.07m (21'11" x 10'1") Double glazed doors to rear, double glazed window to side, range of wall and base units, fitted oven, gas hob and extractor fan, stainless steel sink with mixer tap, integrated washing machine, fridge/freezer, microwave, larder storage cupboard, radiator, tiled flooring.

Landing Single glazed window to side, hatch providing access to loft, coved ceiling.

Bedroom 1 4.78m x 3.5m (15'8" x 11'6") Double glazed windows to front, radiator, wood flooring.
